INSV Tarini to depart from Fremantle on 5 November 2017



Indian Naval Sailing Vessel (INSV) Tarini had arrived in Fremantle on 23 October 2017 as part of its maiden voyage to circumnavigate the world. The journey, Navika Sagar Parikrama, is the first-ever Indian circumnavigation of the globe by an all-women crew.

INSV Tarini is expected to depart from Fremantle on 5 November 2017 (1200 hrs) for its onward journey to Lyttleton (New Zealand). You are invited to Fremantle Sailing Club to see off INSV Tarini and its crew on second leg of their historic journey.

The expedition, Navika Sagar Parikrama, is being covered in five legs, with stop-overs at 4 ports: Fremantle (Australia), Lyttleton (New Zealand), Port Stanley (Falklands), and Cape Town (South Africa). The vessel would return to Goa in April 2018, on completion of the voyage.
