Know India Programme (KIP) is an engagement programme for Diaspora Youth of Indian origin between 18 to 30 years, to introduce them to India and promote awareness about different facets of Indian life, cultural heritage and various aspects of contemporary India.

Ministry of External Affairs has announced 49th to 52nd KIPs on the KIP Portal. Details of these KIPs are as follows:

49th	20 Nov – 14 Dec 2018	Andhra Pradesh
50th	15 Dec- 8 Jan 2019	Maharashtra and Daman & Diu
51st	5 -29 Jan 2019	Gujarat
52nd	16 Jan – 9 Feb 2019	Jharkhand & Bihar

The content of the programme broadly includes the following:

- Presentations on the country, political process, developments in various sectors.
- Visit to places of historical, cultural, religious importance.
- Presentation on the industrial development and visits to some Industries.
- Visit to a village to better understand the typical village life.
- Familiarisation with art, music and culture of India.

- Visit to places of historical importance/Monuments.
- Visit to a select state in India for 10 days.
- Call on high dignitaries such as Union Ministers, Governor and Chief Ministers of partner states and visit of prominent buildings etc.
